



## Increase to Expense Related Allowances

Expense related allowances have increased in line with changes in the CPI (weighted average of 8 capital cities) between March quarter 2016 and March quarter 2017. The increase is 2.1%.

The increases are effective from Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2016.

The new rates are as follows:

### Clause 9.7 Detectives Allowance

9.7.1 – increase to: \$3,275  
9.7.2 – increase to: \$2,142  
9.7.4 – increase to: \$2,142

### Clause 10.1 Camping & Sea Victualling Expense Allowance

For each 24hr period:

With cook: \$34.80  
Without cook: \$64.50

For less than 24hrs:

With cook: \$27.80  
Without cook: \$51.50

### Clause 10.2 Incidentals Expenses

Within Tasmania: \$20.50 per overnight absence  
Outside Tasmania: \$28.85 per overnight absence

### Clause 10.3 Community Assistance Expense Allowance

Increase to: \$2,900 per annum

### Clause 10.4 Isolated Community Assistance Expense Allowance

*Alannah, Currie, Lady Barron or Whitemark:*  
First two years: \$9,279 per annum  
Each year thereafter: \$6,378 per annum

*Gladstone, Liawenee, Waratah, Queenstown, Rosebery, Strahan, and Zeehan:*

First two years: \$6,378 per annum  
Each year thereafter: \$3,481 per annum

### Clause 10.5 Meal Expense Allowances

Increase from \$12.00 wherever appearing in Clause 10.5 to \$12.40.

Increase from \$22.95 where it appears in Clause 10.5.4 to \$23.75.

### Clause 10.6 Motor Vehicle Expense Allowance

	2 litres or more, cents per km	Less than 2 litres, cents per km
First 10,000kms	55.53 cents	47.77 cents
Any additional km	29.42 cents	25.55 cents

### Clause 10.7 Licensing Allowance

10.7.1 – increase to: \$2,142  
10.7.2 – increase to: \$1,571

### Clause 10.8 Overnight Expense Allowances

10.8.6 – Incidentals:

Allowance where meals and sleeping quarters are provided:

Within Tasmania: \$20.50 per overnight absence  
Outside Tasmania: \$28.85 per overnight absence

### Clause 10.9 Plain Clothes Expense Allowance

Regularly required to wear plain clothes - \$2,468. pa  
Protective clothing - \$1,573. pa  
Permanent transfer to plain-clothes duty, initial advance payment - \$1,234.

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Wearing of plain clothes on an occasional basis: \$9.70 per day

Full board and lodging provided:

\$21.05 per day (first 6 weeks)

Accommodation only provided:

\$67.50 per day (first 6 weeks)

Increase to: \$2,993

#### Clause 11.6 Depreciation Expenses

Value between \$1 and \$3,999 - \$300;

Value between \$4000 and \$20000 - \$593

Value \$20001 and above - \$1,070

#### Clause 11.7 Removal Expenses

Increase to: \$2,318

For King Is and Flinders Is: \$8,972

#### Clause 11.10 Education Assistance Expenses

Increase to: \$702

#### Clause 20 PSS & TSS

20.8 increase to: \$117.15 per day

20.10 (a) increase to: \$2,142

20.10 (b) increase to: \$1,571

21.7 (a) – increase to: \$117.15 per day

### Increase to Salary

A salary increase is due to be paid effective from 13 July 2017.

There will be a 0.5% increase to base salary paid to Constable, levels 12, 13(i) and 13(ii), Sergeant, levels 6, 7(i) and 7(ii), and Inspector, levels 5(i) and 5(ii).

An increase of 2% to base salary for all levels within the Constable, Sergeant and Inspector ranks is effective from 13 July as well. The Police Award rate for Commanders will also increase by 2%.

These increases will have a flow on effect to numerous salary based allowances such as:

- ◆ Higher duties Allowance,
- ◆ Shift-in-Charge Allowance – 24hr stations,
- ◆ Country Police Station Allowance,
- ◆ Specialist Allowance,
- ◆ Sea Going Allowance,
- ◆ Skippers Allowance,
- ◆ Availability and Standby,
- ◆ Shift and Penalty Allowance, and
- ◆ Dog Handlers Allowance

Overtime and call back rates will also increase.

### Increase to PAT Subscriptions

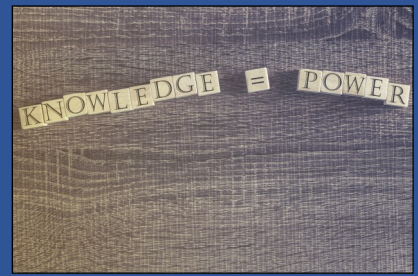
As a result of the salary increase a number of Police Association membership benefits will also increase such as the amounts available to members for legal assistance, welfare assistance, legacy payments and payments for death benefits.

The salary increase has resulted in an increase to the subscription rates. The increase will apply from payday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2017.

The new rates are as follows:

- Fulltime rate: from \$37.37 per fortnight (p/f) to \$38.11 p/f;
- Trainees until graduation: from \$18.68 p/f to \$19.05 p/f;
- Part-time members:
  - ◆ Average of 1 to 37 hrs per p/f: from \$18.68 p/f to \$19.05 p/f;
  - ◆ Average of 38 to 57 hrs p/f: from \$28.03 p/f to \$28.59 p/f; and
  - ◆ Average of 58 hrs or more p/f: from \$37.37 p/f to \$38.11 p/f.

*Remember, these figures are GST inclusive which means 10% goes straight to the taxman!*



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
